Acacia greggii Catclaw Acacia, Wait-a-minute Bush

SHRUB - deciduous.
5'+ high, to 10' spread.
Leaves gray-green.
Several 1' long golden yellow flowers per stem - spring.
Curved spines on the stem.

Native habitat: Desert washes and canyons generally below 6000'.

Full sun.

Tolerates alkaline or sandy soil. Drought tolerant.

Many ethno-botanical uses for the seed pods and other parts of the plant.

Phainopeplas use the seeds and trees. Many butterflies visit the flowers.

Associated plants include *Prunus* fremontii, Quercus agrifolia and Justicia californica.
