## Ambrosia Chenopodifolia San Diego Bur-sage

PERENNIAL SHRUB.
To 11' high, rounded; many branches.
Leaves coated in white hairs.
Flowers are inconspicuous; monoecious; February to May.
Fruit have dense hooked spines.
Native habitat: coastal sage scrub below 850', southwest San Diego County to Baja California.

Full sun or part shade. Little (1 - 2 x/month) to no summer water, once established.

Good color contrast. Best away from traffic.
