

Antigonon leptopus
San Miguel Coral Vine

VINE

SPRAWLING OR CLIMBING TO 40'. Vigorous.

Leaves heart-shaped.

Bright coral-pink to red flowers in sprays - summer to early fall.

Native habitat: chaparral, scrub - bluffs, foothills below 3000' in Baja California.

Full sun to part shade.

Sandy well-drained moderately fertile loam. (Too much nitrogen will cause rank growth and poor flowering.)

Water 2 x / month once established.

Good for covering buildings, arbors and screens in the tropics, more restrained in cooler climates.

Prune back in spring to control growth.
