Arctostaphylos hookeri 'Monterey Carpet' Monterey Carpet Manzanita

LOW SHRUB - evergreen.
To 1' high, 5 - 8' spread. Compact, slow growing.
Leaves small, bright green, held erect.
Flowers white to pink - late winter to early spring.

Horticultural selection - cuttings from central coast, sandy soils and forest openings (Monterey Peninsula).

Sun to partial shade.

Needs well-drained soils, prefers acidic.

Grows on coast or inland, but inland needs protection from heat and sun.

Does better with some supplemental water.

Useful as ground cover on slopes and for understory planting.
