

Arctostaphylos franciscana (*A. hookeri* ssp. f.)
Franciscan Manzanita

SHRUB, evergreen.

Prostrate, mounding to 5.' Groundcover.

Leaves smooth, bright green.

Flowers white to pale pink — January to April.

Native habitat: serpentine soil in chaparral, below 500'
— San Francisco.

Full sun.

Tolerates clay soils.

Good ground cover.

Good for birds.

Only one plant in wild, others are cultivated.

(Rare, threatened or endangered in California and elsewhere.
Seriously endangered in California). Federally endangered.
