Arctostaphylos glandulosa : Eastwood Manzinita

SHRUB, evergreen.
To 3' high, spreading to 7'.
Leaves light, silvery green.
Flowers white — January to
April.
Smooth red stems.

Native habitat: chaparral, conifer forest, 5000' to 7000' — Southwest California to Baja California.

Full sun.
Little water needed once established.

Tolerates deer. Attracts hummingbirds. Berries edible.
