Arctostaphylos otayensis Otay Manzanita

SHRUB - evergreen.
3 to 8' high. Erect.
New leaves covered with fine hairs, becoming smooth, slight whitish covering.
Flowers white or very pale pink.
Twigs covered with dense fine hairs.
Smooth red bark.

Native habitat: Volcanic rock outcrops, chaparral, woodland, 2000' to 5500' — southwest Peninsular Range near San Diego.

Full sun or part shade. Frost resistant. Water 1 x /month.
