

Arctostaphylos pajaroensis 'Brother James'

Pajaro Manzanita

SUBSHRUB - evergreen
2 - 3' high, spreading.
Leaves reddish-green.
Flowers pale pink - spring.

Horticultural selection from *A. pajaroensis* by Brother James,
Mission San Juan Batista.

Full sun to shade.
Frost tolerant.
Well-drained soil.
Water 2 - 4 x / month.

Use as small specimen or in a narrow flower bed.
Attracts birds and butterflies.
