

Bebbia Juncea

Rush Sweetbush

SHRUB/SUBSHRUB

2' high, 3' spread.

Brittle stems.

Leaves small, green; absent on some stems.

Small, composite yellow flowers most of the year, but mainly January to July.

Native habitat: creosote bush scrub; rocky and sandy soils on dry hillsides, desert washes, canyons below 4000' — California to Nevada, New Mexico, Texas, Utah and Baja California.

Full sun.

Needs good drainage, preferable with sandy soil.
