Berberis 'Golden Abundance' Hybrid Oregon Grape

SHRUB - Evergreen.
5 - 8' high, 6' spread.
Many basal stems, dense foliage.
Large, shiny, dark green,
pinnate, prickly leaves;
new growth bronze.
Compact clusters of yellow
flowers - April to May.
Deep purple berries sometimes
turn red as they dry in fall.

Hybrid: *Berberis piperiana* x (*B. aquifolium* x *amplectans*)

Full sun to part shade inland. Frost resistant.

Well-drained soil best, but can tolerate heavy soils if not overwatered.

Best with some summer water (3 - 4 x / summer)

Use as a screen, hedge or accent.
