

Calliandra peninsularis
Red Fairy Duster

SMALL SHRUB, semi-deciduous
4 - 5' high. Branches from base.
Leaves feathery, delicate, twice divided.
Flowers showy, bright red — January to March.

Native habitat: sandy slopes and mesas below 4000'
- Baja California.
Full sun to light shade.
Well drained soil.
Best with periodic deep water.

Leaves not shed if watered regularly.
Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies.
