

Calochortus dunnii
Dunn's Mariposa Lily

PERENNIAL, from bulb.

To 2' high.

Basal leaves waxy, wither at time of flowering.

6 to 8 white to pale pink, bell-shaped flowers per inflorescence
- spring.

Native habitat: dry stony ridges; chaparral, yellow-pine forest;
southern Peninsular Ranges of San Diego County to Baja
California - 5000' to 6000.'

Part shade.

Summer dormant.

Needs well-drained soil.

No summer water.

RARE - CNPS List 1B.1

(Rare, threatened or endangered in California and elsewhere.
Seriously endangered in California).
