MEDIUM SHRUB - evergreen.

5 - 7' high, 6' wide.

Mounding, dense.

Narrow, dark, glossy green leaves, heavily wrinkled.

Deep cobalt blue flowers in tight round clusters - April.

Hybrid from C. impressus x C. papillosus var. rowensus.

Full sun. Frost resistant.

More tolerant than other Ceanothus to heavy soils, but good drainage still advised.

Water 1 - 2 / x month once established. No overhead water.

One of the most striking flowering cultivars. Good on slopes and in large scale natural plantings around native oaks and pines.
