

Ceanothus cyaneus

Lakeside Lilac, San Diego Ceanothus

SHRUB - evergreen

3 - 12' high, as wide.

Dense, rounded shrub with angled branches.

Leaves light green.

Long spikes of very showy, bright blue flowers - May to June.

Native habitat: chaparral, foothills <3500' - San Diego County.

Full sun.

Frost resistant.

Well-drained soil.

Will not tolerate summer water. No water once established.

Works best in coastal or inland foothills.

Plant on slopes and let survive under natural conditions.

Can be short-lived.

RARE - CNPS List 1B.2

(Rare, threatened or endangered in California and elsewhere.

Fairly endangered in California).
