

Ceanothus otoyensis
Otay Manzanita, Otay Mountain Lilac

SHRUB - evergreen.

3 - 5' high, 1 - 3' spread. Multi-stemmed plant.

Leaves small, rolled, gray-green.

Flowers white - spring.

Native habitat: rocky exposed ridges in chaparral - Otay Mountain, San Diego with one population in Baja California.

Full sun. Doesn't do well in extremes of heat and cold.

Tolerates poor soil.

Good planted with mainly low-growing shrubs such as *Salvia munzii*, *Viguiera laciniata*

Best planted near the coast.

(distribution in highly restricted occurrences; endangered throughout range: endemic to California: rare outside California).
