PERENNIAL SHRUB

1.5' high 3' wide spreadin

1.5' high, 3' wide, spreading, evergreen. Fragant member of mint family, slow to moderate growth.

White flowers Mar - July.

Native Habitat: Rocky slopes, chaparral in Peninsular Range of Orange County and San Diego into Baja Ca. Elev. 1500' - 3500'

Full sun to partial shade Well-drained soil.
Low water use, but better with regular water.
1x-2x/month in summer.
