Cornus sericea (C. stolonifera, C. californica) American or Red Stem Dogwood

SHRUB - deciduous.

12' high,10' spread.

Open growth.

Large oval green leaves.

When leaves fall can see attractive red bark.

Showy white flowers clusters - spring.

Native habitat: Moist areas below 9000' - Mexico to Alaska (uncommon in California).

Part shade to shade.
Water 4 x /month to keep soil moist.

Useful bordering lawns or along a stream.

Inland leaves turn red, yellow, pink in fall
