PERENNIAL/SUBSHRUB

8 - 20" high.

Broom-like branches.

Narrow, linear leaves.

Yellow flowers in clusters - March to October.

Native habitat: Dry, sunny slopes - coast ranges from San Diego  
to north coast.

Full sun.

Little summer water.

Useful in rock gardens. Provides color for long period.
