Delphinium parryi Blue Larkspur

PERENNIAL - deciduous
Flower stalk to 3'
Attractive basal leaves present
early spring then usually
gone before flowers appear.

Flowers are very striking with multiple blossoms along the stalk; March to July.

Native habitat: Chaparral,
Coastal Sage Scrub, usually
on slopes; below 8500' Central Western California,
Southwest California to Baja
California

Full sun to part shade.
Best in rocky or sandy soil, but
will tolerate richer soils.
Must be allowed to go dormant in
summer (dry).

Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies. Toxic to many animals.
