PERENNIAL SUCCULENT - evergreen.

Forming clumps.

Oblong, slightly tapered leaves in basal rosette.

Flowers pale yellow with reddish lines at the keel; branched - spring.

Native habitat: rocky places, 2500' to 6000' - Peninsular Ranges to northern Baja California.

Sun to partial shade. Frost tolerant.

Do not water in summer unless in sandy soil or in a container.

Use in rock gardens or containers. Good as long-lived specimen plant.
