

Dudleya farinosa

Bluff Lettuce

PERENNIAL HERB, evergreen.
Inflorescence to 14" high,
rosettes 2-10" wide.
Leaves usually powdery, often with
red edging.
Flowers in peduncles, pale yellow to
orange - June to August.

Native Habitat: coastal soils and cliffs < 2400' from Santa Barbara to southern Oregon

Full sun to partial shade.
Likes poor soil.
Water occasionally or leave dry.

Good for rock gardens, borders or on walls.
Attracts hummingbirds.
