SUCCULENT - evergreen rosette. Leaves to 6" long , rosette 6" across. Leaves silver gray. Flowers white - May to June.

Native habitat: Catalina Island, on rocks and cliffs below 1200'.

Full sun. Needs protection from frost. Needs good drainage, but can tolerate heavy soil. Water sparingly.

Best dudleya for groundcover. Forms dense clusters. Good for rock gardens, container gardening. Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies.
