Sticky Dudleya

SUCCULENT.

Rosette.

Sticky dark green leaves.

Flowers white with red, lined markings - May to June.

Native habitat: coastal sage scrub; dry rocky places below
1200' - San Juan Capistrano to near Oceanside.

Full sun to part shade.

Drought tolerant.

Water sparingly.

Good in rock gardens, rocky slopes.
