Elymus glaucus (Leymus glaucus) **Blue Wild Rye**

PERENNIAL BUNCH GRASS

1.5 - 5' high.

Small, narrow tufts from fibrous root system.

Flat, blue-green leaves, ending in a point.

Narrow, 4 - 6" long spikes of florets — May to July.

Native habitat: prairies, grasslands, meadows below 14000' throughout California other than low desert.

Full sun to part shade.
Frost resistant.
Tolerates alkaline soil, sand, clay, serpentine and seasonal flooding.
Summer deciduous without water, but can be watered 1-2 x / month.

Attracts bees and butterflies. Easy to grow.
