## Common Horsetail

ANNUAL FFRN

Stems of two kinds:

Sterile, to 2' tall, green, branching.
Fertile Stem, to 1' tall, un-

branched, brown, fleshy, segmented; growing from underground rhizome.

Sterile green stems grow after fertile stems have wilted — March to May.

Native habitat: streambeds, wet meadows, other wet areas — in many parts of California, USA, Europe, Asia, below 1000.1

Full to part shade. Requires regular watering.

Use in ponds, bird gardens.
