

Ericameria cuneata

Compact or Wedgeleaf Goldenbush

WOODY PERENNIAL

6 - 20" high. Dense, compact.
Tiny deep green leaves.
Yellow disk-type flowers - late
summer, early fall.

Native habitat: cliffs and slopes,
especially in clefts of
granitic rocks, Pinyon-
Juniper woodland, Yellow
Pine forest, 4,000 - 7500'
— mountains of northern
Baja California to ranges
surrounding Mojave Desert,
Sierra Nevada, Arizona and
Nevada.

Full sun.
Coarse, sandy soils.
Excellent drainage.

Good in rock gardens and as
groundcover.
