HERBACEOUS PERENNIAL

1' high, 4' spread. Low habit.

Blue-green leaves, basal in clumps.

White to lavender flowers — spring to late summer.

Native habitat: coastal bluffs, dunes and beaches below 100'
— coastal California, northern Channel Islands, Oregon.

Full sun to part shade.

Best on coast.

Salt-spray tolerant.

Best with good drainage.

Water 2 - 4 /month.

Good in rock gardens, borders and along paths or in front of shrubs.
