Fouquieria splendens Ocotillo

LARGE SHRUB - drought deciduous. 15 - 20' high.

Stiff, spiny stems fan up and outward from the base.

Small, oval, bright green leaves after rains.

Bright red flowers in clusters at tips of stems - March to July.

Native habitat: creosote brush - dry, rocky places below 2500' -Mojave Desert and Colorado Desert to Texas and Mexico.

Full sun. Needs good drainage. No summer water.

Best inland. Good accent plant. Flowers popular with hummingbirds.
