

Hazardia cana

San Clemente Island Hazardia

BUSHY SHRUB - evergreen.

4 - 7' high, 2 - 3' wide, upright.

Woolly, oblong leaves that are sometimes toothed.

Yellow flowers that may age to red/purple at ends of grayish stems - winter/spring.

Native habitat: Coastal scrub, coastal bluff scrub, riparian scrub
- below 1500' - San Clemente Island and Guadalupe Island.

Full sun to part shade.

Drought tolerant, but can tolerate some water.

Well drained soil.

Afternoon shade and some summer water in inland areas.

Fast growing.

Attractive foliage.

Good for coastal gardens.
