## Island Hazardia

SHRUB - Stress deciduous.

To 8' high.

Leaves are thick and usually serrated.

Groups of yellow flowers that can turn red-purple.

Dense hairs give the plant a gray color.

Native habitat: On canyon walls and rocky slopes below 1000'  
- endemic to Channel Islands.

Full sun to part shade.

Will tolerate clay and coastal conditions.

Water 1 - 2/month once established.

Unusual leaves and flowers make this a useful contrast plant.

Useful in bird gardens.

(Of limited range in California and elsewhere.

Not very threatened in California).
