PERENNIAL HERB

To 12" high, to 4' spread.

Leaves fleshy green.

Flowers white with green or purple centers along a coiled spike

- March to October.

Native habitat: salty soils below 4000' - throughout California to Arizona, Nevada and throughout subtropical and tropical America.

Full sun to part shade. Not Frost tolerant.

Tolerates poor soil.

Prefers moist soil, but can tolerate drought.

Rock gardens, near ponds.
