Heuchera hirsutissima 'Santa Rosa' Island Alum Root

HERBACEOUS PERENNIAL evergreen.
6-12" high forming creeping mats.
Flower stem 8-12".
Leaves multi-lobed.
Bell-shaped flowers in open clusters on slender stems, white.

Horticultural selection from Santa Rosa Island where it grows over and around rocks on shaded slopes.

Part shade to full shade.

Drought tolerant once established, but looks better with some summer water (2 x /month).

Good in rock gardens. Attracts hummingbirds. Good long-lasting cut flowers.
