

Hosackia (Lotus) crassifolius var. *otayensis*
Otay Mountain Lotus

PERENNIAL

2' high, 3' spread. Stems erect.
Leaves light green, hairy. Stems hairy.
Flowers reddish - spring.

Native habitat: disturbed areas in chaparral around 3,000' -
Otay Mountain, San Diego.

Full sun to part shade.
Water 1 x month after established.

RARE — CNPS List: 1B.1

(Rare, threatened or endangered in California and elsewhere.
Seriously endangered in California.)
