Hyptis emoryi & Cultivars **Desert-Lavender**



PERENNIAL SHRUB. 4 - 10' high, 4 - 6' spread. Aromatic (lavender-like). Leaves are gray/silver, woolly. Flowers a dark lavender - all year, especially winter months.

Native habitat: Desert scrub, in canyons and sandy washes below 3000' - Mojave and Sonora Deserts to Arizona and northwestern Mexico.

Full sun to part shade. Needs good drainage. Very drought tolerant. Water 1 X / month.

Good for color contrast. Combines well with succulents. Attracts hummingbirds and insects. Can be used in potpouri.
