Iris douglasiana 'Canyon Snow' Douglas or Coast Iris

HERBACEOUS PERENNIAL

1' high, 4' spread. Clumping.

Spreading by rhizome.

Long shiny green leaves.

Pure white flowers with yellow nectar guides - February to May.

Horticultural selection from Iris douglasiana 'Alba.'

Sun to part shade.

Frost tolerant.

Can tolerate range of soil. Loose, rich soil encourages growth and spreading of rhizomes.

Needs some year-round water - (1 - 2 x /month) once established.

Divide rhizomes in fall.

Good border or accent plant.

Lovely in clumps, mats, among or under trees and shrubs.
