

Lepechinia fragrans

Fragrant Pitcher Sage

SHRUB - semi deciduous

3' high, 4' spread.

Upright growth.

Leaves are oval-shaped, gray-green, very fragrant.

Pendular flowers along 1 to 2' stems, lavender, to 1.5" -
spring to early summer.

Native habitat: chaparral in canyons below 4000' - southern
coast, northern Channel Islands.

Full sun to part shade.

Water 1 - 2 x /month once established.

Pinch back new growth to get denser plant.

Good in border mixed with plants such as *Sisyrinchium bellum*,
Eschscholzia californica.
