Lessingia filaginifolia var. californica (now Corethrogyne californica) Beach Aster, Sand Aster, Carmel Aster

PERENNIAL 1' high, 4 - 6' spread. Silver/white leaves tapered and toothed. Flower heads lavender - summer to fall.

Native habitat: coastal sage scrub, oak woodlands, grasslands below 3500' — central western and north coastal California to southwest Oregon.

Full sun to part shade. Good drainage. Little summer water (1 - 2 x /month).

Attractive groundcover.

Varieties can intergrade. Do not plant near native Corethrogyne filaginifolia species.
