

*Lilium humboldtii*  
Humboldt Lily

HERBACEOUS PERENNIAL

3 - 8' high.

Bright green to purple leaves.

Striking nodding flowers golden orange with maroon spots - June to July.



Native habitat: chaparral, yellow pine forest; open flats, 4000 to 5500' - Cascade Range to Sierra Nevada to mountains of east San Diego County.

Full sun to part shade.

Frost resistant.

Too much water may cause bulbs to rot.



Good at back of mixed border.

Favorite food for gophers!
