PERENNIAL SHRUB/VINE

4'-8', sprawling, twining.

Leaves opposite, oblong, often fused. Winter deciduous.

Flowers two-lipped, pink in spikes - May-June

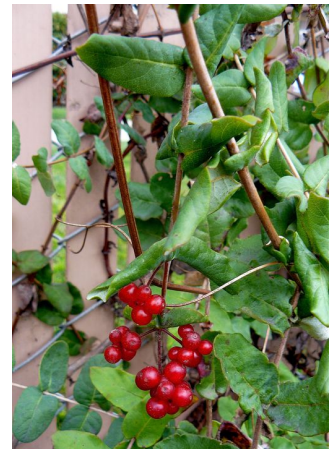
Native Habitat: Slopes and streambanks below 2500'.
Mostly coast ranges to southern Oregon.

Partial sun.

Tolerates clay, not particular.

Needs winter/spring water. Monthly summer water.

Can be trained to trellis or larger shrub
