

# *Mimulus 'Eleanor'* (*Diplacus* sp.) Eleanor Monkeyflower

PERENNIAL SHRUB  
2-3' high and wide, dense.  
Sturdy, erect stems.  
Leaves elliptic to lance shaped; green.  
Flowers buttery yellow with white  
edges and orange markings in throat.  
Spring to summer.

Native Habitat: horticultural selection.

Sun to partial shade.  
Well-drained loam, clay, DG.  
Summer water 1-2x/month, as  
needed.

Can be used in pots or planters.  
Cut back to 8" after flowering.
