

*Monardella macrantha*  
Red Monardella

PERENNIAL HERB - drought deciduous

To 1' high, in tufts to 2'

Shiny dark green leaves to 1 inch long

Lightly scented

Several tubular, red-tinged flowers to 1.5 inches long, in a cluster; can be yellowish - June

Native habitat: Chaparral and woodland above 4000' - Coastal Ranges, Monterey to Baja California

Part shade

Will tolerate clay soil

Water 1 x / week once established

Good in rock gardens

Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies
