

Monardella villosa

Coyote Mint

HERBACEOUS PERENNIAL

2' high, 2' spread.

Decumbent.

Dark green leaves - slightly fuzzy -
to very woolly. Aromatic.

Lavender flowers in spring and
summer.

Native habitat: mixed evergreen
forest, north coastal scrub -
dry rocky and gravelly places
below 3000' in northern to
central California.

Part shade to full shade.

Frost resistant.

Water 1 - 2 x / month.

Attracts butterflies.
