

Nolina bigelovii
Bigelow's Nolina

PERENNIAL - evergreen.

3' high, 8' high flower stalk; 3 - 6' wide.

Thick woody trunk with age.

Dense crown of narrow, rigid, gray-green leaves, serrated when young and shedding fiber when mature.

Dense flower clusters on tall stalk - May to June.

Native habitat: rocky slopes and ridges, 1000' - 5000' -
Desert Mountains, Sonoran Desert, Nevada, Arizona,
northwestern Mexico.

Full sun. Frost tolerant.

Good drainage.

Drought tolerant.

Rock gardens. Good accent plant away from high traffic areas.
