### PERENNIAL TREE

25' tall x 25' wide at crown

Upright, thornless, smooth, lime-green bark.

Palo verde means "green stick" in Spanish.

Leaves pinnate compound, leaflets small and bright green

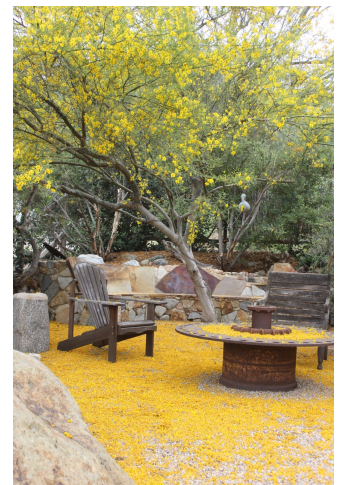
Bright yellow flowers in masses - March - May and sporadically during summer

Native Habitat: Desert Museum is a three-way cross between two native trees and a California non-native, *P. aculeata*. Each of the parents are from deserts, often washes.

Full sun

Well-drained soil.

Water 1x/month in summer
