

Penstemon eatonii

Eaton Firecracker, Eaton's Penstemon

PERENNIAL

1 - 3' high, shrubby.

Bluish-green leaves.

Narrow, tubular, scarlet flowers - March to July.

Native habitat: gravelly or rocky desert washes and canyon floors; creosote bush scrub, dry sagebrush scrub and juniper pinyon woodland below 4000' - Sonora Desert and desert mountains of Riverside and San Bernardino counties to Colorado and New Mexico.

Full sun.

Tolerates heat.

Needs excellent drainage.

Best with some summer water.
