

Penstemon rostrifolius
Bridge Penstemon

PERENNIAL, deciduous.

3' high, 15 - 18" wide.

In clumps from a woody base.

Leaves linear.

Flowers bright orange/red, 1" long - June to August.

Native habitat: sagebrush or Joshua-tree scrub, woodland, montane forest; Sierra Nevada, southwestern California east of Sierra Nevada and desert mountains - 5000' - 9000'.

Full sun to part shade.

Frost tolerant.

Likes cool summer nights.

Well-drained soil.

Flowers longer with some water.

Can be a mass of flowers.

Loved by hummingbirds.
