

Phacelia grandiflora

Giant-Flower Phacelia

ANNUAL, erect.

3' high.

Leaves up to 6" long, toothed.

Flower inflorescence is curved,
flowers bell-shaped, purple
to blue, to 1" - April to June.

Native habitat: disturbed
areas especially following
fires; coastal sage scrub,
chaparral; coastal hills,
Transverse Ranges of
southern California and Baja
California.

Full sun.

Likes sandy soils.

Striking plant.

Seeds will not tolerate summer water. If
not watered, seeds may produce
