Pinus edulis Piñon Pine

SMALL CONIFER - evergreen.10 - 20' high, 10'+ spread.Broad, flat-top form with numerous trunks from base.Usually broader than tall.Dark green needles, 2/bundle.

Native habitat: woodland - desert mountains 4500 - 9000'.

Full sun to part shade. Frost and drought resistant. Little or no water (1 x / month).

Very slow growing stately tree. Good in rock gardens and containers, and for screen plantings. Seeds are an important food.
