## Pinus lambertiana Sugar Pine

WHITE PINE TREE,
evergreen.
To 100' high, trunk to 8'
diameter.
Needles in bundles of 5,
2-4.5" long
Cone is pendant, to 2' long.



Native habitat: yellow and red pine forest; mountainous areas below 1050' — Oregon to northern Baja California.

Full sun to part shade.
Frost tolerant.
Adaptable to soil types.
Does not require much
water.

Tallest pine species. Pine nuts are edible. Prune in winter. Can stabilize banks.
