

Quercus chrysolepsis
Canyon Oak, Maul Oak

LARGE TREE - evergreen

15 - 40' high, 30'+ spread.

Bark whitish to pale gray.

New twigs golden.

Leaves variable in shape - dark green above, pale beneath with golden fuzz when young.

Acorns large - corky cups.

Native habitat: chaparral, mixed-evergreen forest, woodland; canyons and moist slopes in foothills and mountains, 600 - 6500' - Baja California to Oregon.

Full sun to part shade.

Frost resistant. Best inland.

Adaptable to soils.

Water 1 - 2 x / month.

Can grow moderately fast with some summer moisture.

Acorns attract birds and small animals.
